*Syllabus for Entrance Test Examination of Certificate in Turkish*

**Time: 1 hr 30 minutes**

**Marks: 100**

The Entrance Test for Certificate in Turkish will comprise of two parts: Part-A & Part-B.

1. **Part-A** will consist of **40** objective type multiple choice questions related to General Knowledge, Current Affairs, History, Science & Social Science of one mark each. There will be negative marking in Part-A with a weightage of 0.25 marks for each wrong answer. Time Duration will be 30 minutes.
2. **Part-B** will consist of subjective type descriptive questions with a weightage of **60** marks consisting of six questions of ten marks each pertaining to: (a) The country profile of Turkey (b) Essay on renowned literary/political personalities of Turkey or India (c) Indo-Turkish relations (past & present) (d) Relevance and importance of learning Turkish language (e) Comprehension of unseen passage in English (f) Basic English grammar (preposition/synonyms/antonyms/tenses). Time Duration will be 60 minutes.

*Note: Admission to the Certificate in Turkish shall be done on the basis of merit determined by the result of Entrance Test Examination.*
