Syllabus of the Entrance Test for Certificate in French - 2024

The Entrance Test for Certificate in French will have two parts: Part-A & Part-B.

- 1. **Part-A** will consist of **40** objective type multiple choice questions related to General Knowledge, Current Affairs, History, Science & Social Science of one mark each.
- 2. There will be negative marking in Part-A with a weightage of 0.25 marks for each wrong answer.

Time given for this section will be o minutes.

3. **Part-B** will consist of subjective type descriptive questions with a weightage of **60** marks consisting of six questions of ten marks each pertaining to:(a) The country profile of France & other French speaking countries (b) Essay on renowned literary/political personalities of France (c) Indo-French / Indo Canada relations (past & present) (d) Relevance and importance of learning the French language (e) Comprehension of unseen passage in simple English (f) Basic English grammar (prepositions/synonyms/antonyms/tenses/ etc). Time given for this section will be 60 minutes.
