Syllabus for Entrance Test Examination of Certificate in Korean

Time: 1 hr 30 minutes

Marks: 100

The Entrance Test for Certificate in Korean will comprise of two parts: Part-A & Part-B.

1. **Part-A** will consist of **40** objective type multiple choice questions related to General Knowledge, Current Affairs, History, Science & Social Science of one mark each. There will be negative marking in Part-A with a weightage of 0.25 marks for each wrong answer. Time Duration will be 30 minutes.

2. **Part-B** will consist of subjective type descriptive questions with a weightage of **60** marks consisting of six questions of ten marks each pertaining to: (a) The country profile of South Korea (b) Essay on renowned literary/political personalities of South Korea or India (c) Indo-Korean relations (past & present) (d) Relationship between South and North Korea (e) Relevance and importance of learning Korean language (f) Comprehension of unseen passage in English (g) Basic English grammar (preposition/synonyms/antonyms/tenses). Time Duration will be 60 minutes.

***Note:** Admission to the Certificate in Korean shall be done on the basis of merit determined by the result of Entrance Test Examination.*
